2021 continued to present many challenges in terms of navigating the continuing COVID-19 pandemic. Despite these challenges, 2021 was still a very successful year for MCPAWS! The MCPAWS Veterinary Hospital finished its first full year of operations assisting pets and their people in obtaining vital veterinary care. Our shelter team was able to expand many public services, including adoptions, transfers, reuniting lost pets with their families, and spay/neuter services for owned animals.

In 2021, the thrift store continued to offer the best shopping deals in town! The store also expanded their contribution to our mission by establishing our new Cat Library adoption program. By the end of 2021, nearly half of all cat adoptions occurred right at the store! The library connected more people to our shelter cats and reduced the amount of time our kitties stayed in the shelter.

This success is made possible by many thoughtful, dedicated, and compassionate people. MCPAWS employees ensure that shelter animals are well cared for, that programs are operational and effective, that our marketing is engaging and informative, and that we are able to connect the mission of MCPAWS to our community in a meaningful way. 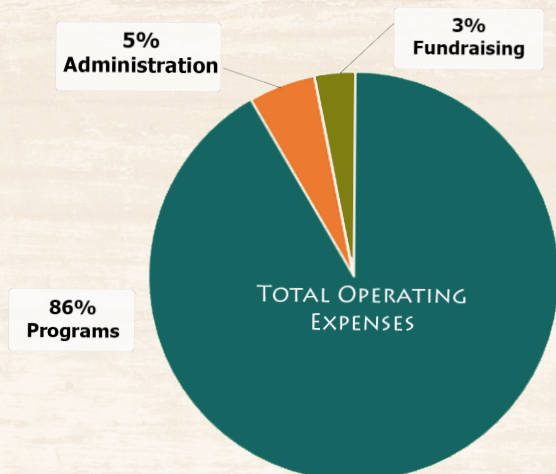
