The Position: MCPAWS Veterinary Hospital is hiring for the position of Registered Veterinary Technician (RVT) to staff our new, full-service veterinary hospital in Donnelly, Idaho. The RVT provides technical assistance to the Veterinarian; assists with the daily care of all hospital patients; handles maintenance of the hospital and patient records; and conducts medical procedures for hospital patients under the supervision of a Certified Veterinarian. The ideal RVT is friendly, compassionate, outgoing, and acts as a main point of contact between the doctor and our clients. Excellent communication skills are required.

Duties of the Position:

- Assist the veterinarian during a wide range of surgeries including, but not limited to: spay/neuter surgeries, dental cleanings and extractions, mass removal, amputations, etc.
- Complete routine treatment and care of patients, including, but not limited to: IV catheter placement, blood draws, diagnostics such as fecal exams, urinalysis, blood work; intubate and induce anesthesia; prepare animals for a wide variety of surgeries
- Monitor patient vitals and anesthesia during surgical procedures
- Assist the veterinarian during daily wellness and problem exams including humane euthanasia
- Complete a wide variety of administrative tasks including keeping patient records updated, transcribing doctor notes into patient database, answering phone calls, scheduling daily appointments, ordering supplies, and updating inventory database
- Administering medications and vaccinations under the direction of a certified veterinarian
- Daily, routine care of hospital patients such as walking dogs, cleaning litterboxes, cleaning kennels, feeding and watering animals, and administering medications.
- Cleaning and sanitizing surgical equipment and instruments
- Daily hospital cleaning duties including, but not limited to, mopping the floor, emptying trash, sanitizing countertops and exam tables
